





# Four Types of Bequests

### Percent Bequest

A percentage bequest is most flexible because it allows your gift to appreciate in your will no matter which asset is used.

Example Language

"I give, devise and bequeath to Point Reyes National Seashore Association, tax ID# 94-2228894, a nonprofit corporation of the State of California, located at 1 Bear Valley Road, Bldg 70 Point Reyes Station, CA 94956, \_\_\_\_% of my estate."

# Specific Bequest

A specific bequest of an asset such as a retirement plan results in no income taxes paid on the plan by your estate.

Example Language

"I give, devise and bequeath	oint Reyes National Seashore Association to tax ID# 94-2228894, a nonprofit corporation
of the State of California, loca	ed at 1 Bear Valley Road, Bldg 70 Point Reyes Station, CA 94956

## Residual Bequest

Residual bequests are often made after remembering relatives and friends, and usually in combination with a percentage bequest.

#### Example Language

"I give, devise and bequeath to Point Reyes National Seashore Association, tax ID# 94-2228894, a nonprofit corporation of the State of California, located at 1 Bear Valley Road, Bldg 70 Point Reyes Station, Ca 94956, all the residue of my estate, including real personal property."

### Contingent Bequest

A contingent bequest allows you to provide a gift to our organization on contingent on no other beneficiaries are able to accept your bequest.

#### Example Language

"In the event of the death of any of the beneficiaries, I give, devise and bequeath to Point Reyes National Seashore Association, tax ID# 94-2228894, a nonprofit corporation of the State of California, located at 1 Bear Valley Road, Bldg 70 Point Reyes Station, Ca 94956, (percentage, specific, or residual language as above)."
